C. NEW BUSINESS

1. New Course Proposal – *ECON 105 Economics in Practice* (DeBoer)

2. New Course Proposal – *MUS ~~131~~ 231 VAPA ~~Voices~~ Vocal Ensemble* (Whitehead)

UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED
5. Pass/Fail – Number of credits allowed pass/fail per semester.

In the Bulletin it states:

“Students may take up to 15 hours of elective credit on a pass/fail basis. Transfer students may take one hour of pass/fail credit for every 8 hours of credit attempted at the University of Colorado. For full-time students, maximum pass/fail hours per semester are as follows:

Fall – 6 credit hours

Spring – 6 credit hours

Summer – 3 credit hours

Winterim – no classes may be taken for pass/fail credit

For part-time students, no more than 50 percent of total credit hours may be taken pass/fail in a given semester. If only one course is taken in a semester, it may be taken pass/fail. The P grade is not included in the student’s grade point average; the F grade is included. A pass/fail designation may not be reversed. . . .” **If the faculty agrees to take off the Winterim restriction, this committee believes the number of credits allowed to be taken pass/fail during winterim should be 3.**
