B. OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Revisal of the LAS Natural Science Lab Requirements.** Presented by Tom Christensen. **Send to Disability Services.**

Recommendation: That the committee does not feel that a change of college policy is warranted.

- 2. New course proposal, Biol 321 “Human Physiology”.** Dr. John Pigage presented arguments for the proposal of Biol 321 answering questions and concerns. **Approved**
- 3. New course proposal, Biol 360/365 “Histology”.** Dr John Pigage presented arguments for the proposal of Biol 360/365 answering questions and concerns. **Approved**
- 4. New course proposal, Biol 478/578 “DNA Technology for Teachers I”.** Already approved by the C&R committee, just needed to reactivate.

Recommendation: Reactivate, but without the “I” attached to the name.

- 5. General Education requirements.** Presented by Tom Christensen. Should some LAS General Education requirements for Education students be satisfied by College of Education classes. **Approved**


Recommendation: That the courses could meet the requirements upon approval of course content. TED 300 needs to get a catalog change. SPED 300 already satisfies.

- 8. Review general requirements for LAS degrees.** Presented by Tom Christensen to see if there were any concerns with the requirements as they are written. **Tabled**


D. DISCUSSION ITEMS
