

MINUTES

Curriculum and Requirements Committee Meeting April 8, 1997

Committee members Tierson, Rice-Jones, Eberhart, Taylor, Christensen, and Welshon were present. Ex-officio members Tom Wynn and Jo Stanbrough were also present. Elaine Prescott was present to take the minutes of the meeting.

A. MINUTES

The minutes of the March 11 meeting were approved.

B. OLD BUSINESS

ID 105 and the Quantitative/Qualitative Reasoning Requirement were discussed. It was agreed upon by the committee to present at the LAS Faculty Meeting on April 18th a definition of the requirement (based on the description from CU Boulder's requirement) and a proposal of how to meet the requirement. The proposal would be take ID 105 or a combination of college algebra and either a course in logic or statistics. Several LAS courses would qualify for the logic component and several others would qualify for the statistics component. It was also discussed that a student could take part of the ID 105 test to test out of the section they have already had.



C. NEW BUSINESS


ENGL 315 - Professional Writing Internship was APPROVED.
