

MINUTES

Curriculum and Requirements Committee Meeting May 13, 1997

Committee members Tierson, Rice-Jones, Eberhart, Christensen, and Welshon and ex-officio member Tom Wynn were present. Elaine Prescott was present to take the minutes of the meeting.

A. MINUTES

The minutes of the April 8 meeting were approved.

B. OLD BUSINESS

The Quantitative/Qualitative Reasoning Requirement was briefly discussed and the definition summarized. A student can test out, take ID 105, or take college algebra and either a symbolic logic course or statistics course. The specific logic and statistics courses were not mapped out. This will not be done until the Fall 1997 semester.

EMST 346 - Contemporary Novel of American Ethnic Minority Experience was approved as a new course with a crosslisting with ENGL 346. It was agreed at the meeting between Tom Napierkowski and José Barrera that they would check with the other department every time the course is offered, so that each department knows ahead of time.

EMST 305 - Race and Ethnicity in American Politics which is crosslisted with Political Science was approved. (It was approved earlier as a Political Science course crosslisted with EMST, but the official crosslisting never reached the Records office.)
