A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES


The February minutes were approved.

B. OLD BUSINESS

1. Offer an LAS B.S. Degree in Physics with a built-in waiver/modification of the natural science requirement. Approved.
2. Articulation Agreement regarding community college core curriculum transfers. Tom Christensen will summarize the options discussed by the Committee and then will take it as a discussion item to the Chairs meeting, and as an informational item to the Faculty meeting.
3. Add PHIL 110 (Philosophical Introduction to Religious Studies) and cross-list with REST 100 (Introduction to Religious Studies). Approved.

C. NEW BUSINESS

1. Change in description and credit hours for PSY 303-2 (Undergraduate Practicum). Approved.
2. HUM 940 (Independent Study) offered as a one-credit course to help fulfill Humanities area requirements. An independent study is normally not allowed to fulfill area requirements; each case would have to be approved by the Committee on Academic Progress and the Dean of the College.
3. Change PHYS 500 from 2 credits to variable 2-3 credits and change course description to include relevance to high school teachers. Approved.
4. Add PES 416 and PHYS 516 (Thin Films Labs) as separate 1-credit labs. Approved.
