A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Add PSY 314 (Cognitive Psychology) as a new course. Tabled. The Committee showed concern regarding the lack of writing required in the course, as well as how the labs will be graded.

2. Change the name of PHIL 320 to "Politics and the Law." Approved.

3. Change the name of ECON 361 to "Economics of Inequality: Income, Poverty, and Distribution." Approved.

4. Add CS 115 (Principles of Computer Science) to the approved list of computer science courses that fulfill the programming language requirement for physics majors. (This was just an informational item.)

D. DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. The Committee will recommend to the faculty that LAS count only work done at CU when figuring GPAs in awarding Latin Honors.

2. The Committee decided not to accept Emergency Medical Technician courses as electives toward LAS degrees.
