Curriculum and Requirements Committee Meeting
January 26, 1999

Committee members present: Tom Christensen, Chair; Paul Harvey, Rebecca Laroche, and Ron Ruminski. Ex-officio members present: Jo Stanbrough and Tom Wynn.

A. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The December minutes will be approved at the February meeting since this was a special meeting.

B. OLD BUSINESS

1. Discussion Items:

- a. Humanities Committee's stand on cross listing Humanities courses (shall not be done) and the Committee's stand on the rule for listing courses to fulfill the General Area Requirement (6 courses per department or separate major, 2 courses per program or minor).

The Committee has no objection to Humanities courses not being cross-listed. It was decided to maintain the status quo and make an accommodation for VAPA regarding courses that fulfill the General Area Requirement.

- b. Discussion on the question on courses that fill the Area Requirements yet are cross-listed with courses that are not on the area requirement lists. How will those courses count?

The Committee suggested that this issue be referred to CAP to make a recommendation to the faculty.

- c. Articulation Agreement (Transfer of Credit)

Currently, we require a portfolio or passing the TSWE for transfer students. This is in violation of the state statute which states that if the core is completed at a community college, then we must take it as fulfilling our lower division requirements. Some solutions to this problem are to do nothing, renumber some


lower division courses, split upper and lower requisites, or create a capstone multi-disciplinary course. This issue was tabled so that the Committee could think of other solutions.

C. NEW BUSINESS

1. Add new course – THTR 260: Theatre for Children. Approved.
2. Add new course – THTR 350: Children’s Theatre Tour. Approved.
3. Add new course – SL 280: Baseball Skills Development: Fundamentals and Principles to be taught through Continuing Education. The Committee approved offering the course under SL270, Special Topics.
