- I. Approved minutes of the 10 March 1992 meeting with one change: COMM 450 should be COMM 400.
- II. COMM 400 - Rhetorical Dimensions of Communication, approved for addition to the list of courses which students may use to satisfy the 6-hour general portion of the 12-hour Humanities Area Requirement.
- III. Recommended that FCS 349/449 be changed to SPAN 349/449 - Internship in Applied Spanish. Understanding is that the chair may count those courses as cultural components of the language major. (See the attached memoranda for the manner in which the Dean has resolved this matter.)

Discussion about whether or not FCS courses belong in foreign language or are cross disciplinary. For example, why are not some anthropology courses crosslisted as FCS courses?

- IV. Arabic 101, 102, and 211 approved. These are telephone-assisted individualized instruction courses.

Displeasure expressed over charging full tuition for a course we do not teach. Why not refund some tuition money back to the student? Concern with the grading system of Ohio State: A, B, or F. Telephone-assisted instruction led to a discussion about teaching courses and not being paid for them, an issue related to the fiber optic system.

- V. R. Foster instructed to communicate the Committee's concerns to Dean Null. Such communication will be accomplished when Dean Null receives a copy of these minutes.
