- II. New Business
  - A. Approved the following new courses from the Department of Communication:
    1. COMM 330 - Scriptwriting
    2. COMM 445 - Advertising Media
  - B. Approved Professor Miller's request (Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures) to renumber all 200 Pronunciation classes to 100.
  - C. Approved ID 205 - Beyond the Finite, as a new course and for addition to list of approved courses to satisfy the general Humanities area requirement. Humanities' chairs will be notified of this addition to the list of courses.
  - D. Approved HIST 475 - Modern Japan, a revised course.
  - E. Approved SOC 361 - Gender and Social Behavior, a revised course.
  - F. Recommended polling the LAS faculty for interest in minors prior to suggesting minimum requirements; suggestion that students should also be polled.
  - G. Recommended that Anth 104 not be permitted as both a substitute for foreign language and a social science area requirement course for any single student.
