- I. Approved the minutes of the 12 Nov. 1991 meeting.
- II. Dean Null announced the appointment of Professor Tierson to chair the committee. Dean Null reported to the Committee concerning faculty discussions about (1) all faculty being associated with departments and (2) the chairs proposal for committees to review all requests for courses to be included on the Area Requirements course lists.
- III. Action on Area Requirements (All to take effect at the beginning of the Summer Semester 1992)
  - A. Approval of motion to remove ID 205 from the Humanities Area Requirement course list.
  - B. Approved Geology's request to add GEOL 102: Historical Geology, to the Geology section of the Natural Science Area Requirement course list.
  - C. Approved the following courses to comprise the English Department's list of courses for the Humanities Area Requirement:
    - ENGL 150: Introduction to Literature
    - ENGL 251: Survey of British Literature I
    - ENGL 252: Survey of British Literature II
    - ENGL 253: Survey of British Literature III
    - ENGL 254: Survey of British Literature IV
    - ENGL 260: Great Books I
- IV. Additional Action:
  - A. Approved a motion to recommend to the Dean that every resident faculty member be placed in a campus department or be associated with a campus department for purposes of curriculum review with the reservation that the area requirement slots go with that resident faculty member.
