I. OLD BUSINESS

A. Minutes of Meeting of February 14, 1989, approved.

B. Memo from Dean Null requesting the C&R Committee to discuss the limitation of the number of credit hours that an LAS student can count from Continuing Education toward an LAS degree. The committee approved a motion to accept 9 semester hours of credit from the Continuing Education Department at UCCS. Courses completed through Q-Net and the Colorado Consortium for Independent Study via Correspondence from CU Boulder are excuded from this restriction.
