I. OLD BUSINESS

A. Minutes of September 12, 1989, approved.

II. NEW BUSINESS

A. LAS Humanities Area Requirement: Memo, English Department request to count Theater 235-3, Acting Workshop, as an addition to the Humanities Area Requirement List, approved.

B. LAS Social Science Area Requirement: Letter, History Department request to count 100 level survey courses in History as part of the Social Science Area Requirement List, no action taken.

The committee recommends that Prof. Dahlin confer with Dean Null on the possibility of presenting this exception to the LAS Faculty at their next faculty meeting.

RATIONALE: The LAS faculty approved a 6 course limit of courses that can be listed from one department for the LAS Area Requirements list in Humanities, Natural Science and Social Science.
