I.     OLD BUSINESS

A.     Minutes of November 14, 1989 meeting, approved.

II.    NEW BUSINESS

A.     LAS Natural Science Area Requirement: Memo, Geology Department, request to use Geol. 466-1, as a Natural Science Area lab requirement, disapproved. The Committee accepted the proposal favorably, but disapproved it for the following reasons.

1. A Lab must be identified as part of a lecture course.
2. The course cannot violate the six hour limit of courses to be counted as Natural Science by a Department. In order for this course to be counted as a Natural Science requirement one course must be dropped from the Geology list of courses on the Natural Science requirement list, (i.e. Oceanography).

B.     New Course: Anth. 499-3, Senior Thesis in Anthropology, approved.

C.     Sport and Leisure Course Title and Number Changes: Memo: Changes in Sport and Leisure course titles and course numbers, approved.
