1. Only ten (10) semester hours of PES 111, 112, 115 and 215 can be counted by a Chemistry major as part of the Natural Science Area Requirements during the Senior Audit for graduation.
2. If a student drops their Chemistry major, PES 111, 112, 115 and 215 will not be counted as part of the Natural Science Area Requirements. Other Natural Science courses from the list must be selected to fulfill the Natural Science Area Requirements.
3. This exception is for Chemistry majors only and will remain in effect until alternative courses in Physics are determined to fulfill the Natural Science Requirements or until the PES portion of the Natural Science Area Requirements have been changed.
