A. Point of information: History Department changes
in introductory courses acknowledged and approved.

B. Double Degree Program: Letter from Dr Thomas G Berry,
Associate Dean, School of Dentistry-CU Health Sciences
Center, Denver, Colorado. Creation of a Double Degree
in Dentistry and College of Letters, Arts and Sciences.
The basic letter was accepted and approved by the
Committee, but changes would be made to reflect respon-
sibilities of the student if they do not complete the
entire dental program. Dr Joan Klingel will write up
the necessary changes.

C. Closed Meeting of Committee:
Discussion on Area Requirements for Humanities, Social
Sciences, and Natural Sciences. Transfer students must
be encouraged to contact the Chairperson of a Department
for exceptions concerning courses completed at other
institutions which are not on the Area Requirement list.
Dr Klingel will write a letter to Dean Null explaining
that exceptions can be made, but only by approval in
writing of a Department Chairperson. The student will
will be responsible to provide course descriptions and
course catalogs or any other supporting documentation.
