LAS Curriculum and Requirements Meeting Friday, October 19, 1973, 9:30 A.M.

Motion to approve minutes of July 18 - July 24 meetings. Prof. Volan moved approval, seconded by Prof. McKay. Motion passed.

1. Prof. Blade moved to approve the Course Outline for Anthropology 430 (Africa Through African Literature) as submitted. Seconded by Prof. McKay. Motion Passed.
2. Prof. McKay moved to approve the Course Outline for Russian 322 (Russian Classics) as submitted. Seconded by Prof. Blade. Motion passed.

New Business: Course Title Changes

1. Prof. Busey moved approval of the credit hour change for physical chemistry, namely the Boulder course listing of Chem 451-3 and Chem 452-3 to LCy 451-4 and LCy 452-4. Seconded by Prof. Volan. Motion passed.
2. Prof. Blade moved approval of the Mathematics course designations from a MaSc prefix to a Math prefix, with the latter carrying a Y designation. Seconded by Mr. Johnson. Motion passed.
3. Prof. Blade moved to approve the following course label changes: MaSc 251 to LPHY 251, MaSc 353 to PHYS 331, and MaSc 499 to LPHY 399. Seconded by Mr. Johnson. Motion passed.

New Business: Course Outlines

1. Prof. Blade moved approval of Geog L330 (Environment, Society and Disease). Seconded by Prof. McKay. Motion passed.
2. The Committee recommended postponing action on Course Outlines for LPY 199-3 (Tutorial in Psychology) and LPY 220-3 (Technical Writing for the Behavioral Sciences) pending further clarification of credit/no credit question on the former course and possible Title and Catalog Description changes on the latter.
3. Prof. Blade moved to approve LPY 452-3 (Current Issues in Clinical Practice). Seconded by Prof. McKay. Motion passed.
