I. OLD BUSINESS:

A. The minutes of November 11, 1981, approved.

II. NEW BUSINESS:

A. New Course: Psychology 465-3, Clinical Neuropsychology, approved.

B. New Course: FAH 480-3, Italian Renaissance I, approved.

C. Cross Listing: FA 404-3, Gallery Management, to be cross-listed as FA 404/FAH 404-3, approved.

III. Discussion:

A. An oral report was presented by the LAS Academic Advisors (J. Buchholz and B. Schultz) on the Developmental programs in English and Reading, and the English 101, 102, and 103 curricula at PPCC.

These academic programs were determined to be adequate for the educational level of the particular student(s) being served. It was recommended that the UCCS-LAS English Department, Dr. Janice Hays, contact PPCC about these programs.

B. A motion was made by Dr. R. Durham to present a resolution to the LAS Faculty to have all UCCS students requiring developmental level English courses to be enrolled in PPCC developmental programs which would be set up to service UCCS.

The motion was seconded and tabled until the LAS English Department had met with the PPCC Developmental Program Department faculty to determine how the program could be set up and implemented.
