LAS Curriculum and Requirements Meeting

February 2, 1973

Motions

2. Pol. Sci. 442-3. Political Theory.

Approved motions:

1. Prof. Busey moved approval of the following Political Science courses with "L" designation:
L Psc 499-~~1-3~~.² Independent Study.
L Psc 699-~~1-3~~.² Graduate Research Topics.
Seconded by Professor Blade. Passed.
2. Prof. Busey moved approval of Span L-422-3. The Novel of the Mexican Revolution. Seconded by Mr. Johnson. Passed.
3. Prof. Busey moved approval of the following proposal for presentation before the LAS Faculty:
It is moved that the present LAS Foreign Language requirement include the option of completing the fourth semester course with a grade of Pass or no less than C.
Seconded by Mr. Johnson. Passed.
4. Prof. McKay moved approval of the following proposal for presentation before the LAS Faculty:
It is moved that the completion of second semester of a Foreign Language with an A grade entitle a student to take the Foreign Language Proficiency Exam; that other students must either be enrolled in or have completed the third semester course, or its equivalent, before taking the exam.
Seconded by Prof. Busey. Passed.
5. Mr. Johnson moved that any work completed outside the regular format of an accredited institution requires the student to validate proficiency by examination.
Seconded by Prof. McKay. Passed.
