II. NEW BUSINESS:

A. New Course: Economics 416, 1-3 hrs of variable credit. Major Concepts  
in Economics and the Social Sciences, approved, as changed.

This course may not be taken by Economics majors. It is  
designed as a 2-credit hr course for teachers and business  
people. It is offered through Continuing Education.  
Prerequisites will include the Consent of the Instructor.

B. New Course: Geology 466/566, 1-3 hrs of variable credit. Field Study  
in Geology, approved, as changed.

The prerequisite will include GEOL 101 and GEOL 102. The  
course will be offered through Continuing Education.

C. New Courses: Theatre 232-1, Stagecraft Lab, approved.  
Theatre 237-1, Speech Lab, approved.

This lab course can be taken only twice for credit with  
a maximum of 2 hrs counted for graduation.
