I. Old Business:

- A. The minutes of February 6, 1981, approved.
- B. New Course: Fine Arts 243-3. Drawing for Non-Art Majors tabled due to lack of instructor support. Dr. Wunderli will write a letter to Lin Fife requesting her presence at the next C&R meeting or a representative.
- C. New Course: Spanish 300-3. Spanish for Medical Personnel, approved with the following change. "Prerequisites: add - With the consent of the instructor."

- A. Course Change: History 432 - Twentieth Century Europe from one semester to two, with course numbers as follows
 - History 445-3 Twentieth Century Europe to 1939 approved.
 - History 446-3 Twentieth Century Europe, 1939 to present, approved.
- B. New Course: Honors 487-1. The Morality of Eating Meat, approved, with the following change: change clock hours from 12 to 13.
