I. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Minutes of April 26 meeting, approved, as changed.
- B. NEW COURSE: PES 104-3, Physics in Science Fiction, approved, as changed. The title must be changed and the words Science Fiction removed from the main title.
- C. NEW COURSE: FAH 383-3, The Artistic Conscience 1848 to 1948, approved, as changed. The following prerequisites are added, FAH 100-3 or 180-3 or 181-3, 280, 281, 282, or 283, HUM 101 or 102, or permission of instructor.
- D. NEW COURSE, SPAN 311-3, Spanish Grammar, approved, as changed.

II. NEW BUSINESS

- A. GRADUATE PROGRAM IN PSYCHOLOGY:  
Dr Lee Becker explained the MS Degree program in Psychology on the UCCS campus. The C&R Committee acknowledged the Psychology graduate program.
- B. GRADUATE PROGRAM IN CHEMISTRY:  
Dr Allen Schoffstall explained his Master of Science degree in Basic Science on the UCCS campus. The C&R Committee acknowledged this program.
- C. AREA REQUIREMENTS:  
The compiled list of Area Requirements were discussed and the following changes were completed or suggestions/recommendations were made.
  - (1) No quantitative methods/statistics courses be counted as part of the Natural Science requirement.
  - (2) All conversation type courses be discounted as part of the Humanities requirement. Only courses in Spanish, French, or German of a literary nature are to be counted as accepted.
  - (3) The PES Department will be requested to resubmit a new list of six courses for the Area Requirements. This list must include all areas of the Physics Department.
  - (4) Music 153, Computer Music-Composition, will not count as a Humanities Area Requirement.
