May 11, 1972

Motions

1. Prof. Blade moved to approve the minutes of the April 20 meeting.  
Seconded by Prof. Scott. Passed.
2. (a) Prof. Busey moved to postpone further discussion concerning the proposed graduate course work in Sociology until such time that Dean Ballantyne can be present.  
Seconded by Prof. Blade. Passed.  
  
(b) Prof. Blade moved to recommend to Dean Ballantyne that he invite Dr. Barbara Lorch to be present at the next meeting to discuss the proposed graduate work in Sociology.  
Seconded by Prof. Busey. Passed.
3. Prof. Busey moved to approve MaSc 260.  
Seconded by Prof. Scott. Passed.
4. (a) Prof. Blade moved that this committee recommend that there not be Physical Education courses on this campus.  
Seconded by Prof. Scott. Passed.  
  
(b) Prof. Blade moved that Physical Education credits no longer be accepted in the College toward fulfilling a degree requirement.  
Seconded by Prof. Busey. Passed.
5. (a) Prof. Busey moved to reject Evi. 208 because the course was essentially the same as the proposed Evi. 209.  
Seconded by Prof. Scott. Passed.  
  
(b) Prof. Blade moved to approve Evi. 209, with a recommendation to the Dean that he consult with Prof. Beyer about the wording of the course description.  
Seconded by Prof. Busey. Passed.  
  
(c) Prof. Busey moved that this committee indicate to the Faculty of Geography that we imply no objection to the offering of Evi. 209 in multiple sections and that the Faculty of Geography be encouraged to submit to the Committee proposals for an introductory survey course in this area of study which would carry course number, description, and credit.  
Seconded by Prof. Scott. Passed.
