LAS Curriculum and Requirements Meeting

July 18, 1973

Members present: Dean Ballantyne (Chairman); Profs. Blade and Volan; Mr. Johnson; Mrs. Baker. No formal motions were made. The introduction of a BS degree to LAS was discussed. Prof. Blade recommended that the 45-hour limit in the major be changed to allow a 45-hour limit in any one discipline.

July 24, 1973

Members present: Dean Ballantyne (Chairman); Profs. Blade, Busey, McKay, Volan.

Matters of business:

1. The course discrepancies listed on the agenda were discussed. Dean Ballantyne has authorized the necessary changes.
2. The Course Outline "Africa Through African Literature" was deferred until the next meeting.
3. Prof. Busey moved to approve Russian 323 "Survey of Russian Culture" on the Foreign Language curriculum. Seconded by Prof. Blade. Motion passed unanimously. Prof. McKay agreed to discuss the course content with Dr. Silverman. The Course Outline for Russian 322, "Russian Classics Revisited," was deferred until a later date.
4. Prof. Busey moved to disapprove for credit the Continuing Education course proposed by Mr. Michael Nevin, "Introduction to the Humanities." Seconded by Prof. McKay. Motion passed unanimously.

5. Prof. Volan moved to accept the proposed military science courses. Seconded by Prof. Blade. Motion passed with one abstention (Prof. Busey).
